Even if you give the contractor photos they have no idea of the actual dimensions of the space, they really need to come and measure up.

Another important thing that you must discuss when your contractor comes to your home is the cost of the renovation. It may take your contractor some time to work out the estimate of the cost, so you should allow them a few days to work this out. After this time make sure you get the quote in writing, also make sure the contractor writes down how long the renovation will take to complete. When you're happy with everything just get your contractor to draw up an official contract for you to sign.
