

## Cleaning Floors Has Become So Easy

This article talks about the benefit of Hardwood floors which are solid and tend to be easier to clean. Besides cleaning the actual hardwood floors, it is essential to follow the dos and don'ts that will keep the floors bright for long.

If you are worried about how to clean your hardwood floors, you should feel at ease as this article will help you through the cleaning process of your floors in a very proper way.

Hardwood floors, which are solid and wooden, tend to be easier to clean. If you take proper care of its maintenance, that increases its life and also its overall appearance. Grit and Dirt are the nemesis of a hardwood floor and create scratches and dents. They also dull the finishing of the smooth surface. Keeping this in mind, you need to follow a daily procedure which will keep the floor clean and long lasting.

Before deciding on how to actually begin cleaning the hardwood floor, it is important to check the condition of the floor. Do you find it scratched in parts, or scraped or chipped? Is the finish dull? If you discover that the finishing is damaged then make sure to never use water on it, as the wood will meet further damage upon coming in contact with water. However, if the finishing is in a good condition than the floor can be washed with a damp mop.

Waxing is also a good option for your hardwood floors. If you have water blot on your waxed finished flooring than take a steel wool, drench it in water and then rub on these stains to remove them. For cigarette burns, you should use a mild soap.

When cleaning the hardwood floors with polyurethane finish, you should first remove all the furniture and rugs which are kept in the room. Then clean the room with a broom or Vacuum the floor. After that soak a mop in soapy water and rub the floor with it followed by a scrubbing of fresh water. Clean the floor with a clean towel till it's dry. When using water on the floor, you should make sure that it does not go into the joints of the wooden floors.

Besides cleaning the actual hardwood floors, it is essential that you make it a routine to follow the dos and don'ts to help preventing the floors getting dirty.

It is important to keep floor mats on all the doorways leading inside the house; this will protect the dirt going on to the hardwood floors. It is very important to use only neutral pH cleaners on the hardwood flooring. When vacuuming the hardwood floors, you must use a brush attached to it. For dust you should use dust mops and floors should be swept regularly. Discoloring will occur when the floor is exposed to direct sunlight. Use blinds, curtains and drapes for blocking the sunlight. Never drag your furniture over a hardwood floor. It is also essential to put some sort of protection on the legs of the furniture to avoid the floor being scratched. The one thing which causes the maximum damage to the wood is water, which should never be left spilled on the floor.
