

The Beautiful Sago Palm Trees

This article talks about how Sago Palms can decorate the interior as well as exterior of your homes. It says that proper Sago Palm care is necessary for a stunning looking plant. It talks about reproduction and seeds of palm.

2708 One of the most prehistoric living plants today is *Cycas Revoluta*, commonly known as The Sago Palm plant. These plants play an important role in beautifying, both the interior and exterior, of a house. These Sago Palm plants are tagged as the most unusually decorative plants that require absolute care & maintenance. They belong to the family of Conifers.

The Sago palms are considered to be the most simplistic and 'homely', as they are characterized as the most appropriate plants to grow at home, whether indoors or outdoors, for which neither do you need any professional help nor gardening expertise. They survive for a tremendously lengthy period of time, and are tolerant of many unusual temperatures, levels of sunlight, and types of care. There are quite a few things to keep in mind with Sago Palm care. Take extra care of the plant as its new leaves emerge and make sure the plant doesn't suffer from dryness during this time. Though usually the Sago Palms are fairly tolerant, temperatures too high or too low can spoil the plant. The growth rate for a Sago Palm is very slow. Most only enlarge in size one inch per year.

Yet another major factor of Sago Palm care is its reproduction. Sago Plants are simultaneously dioecious in nature meaning that there are both male and female plants. The best way to grow these plants is via hand pollination during the month of May as it is considered the best season because the female seed is ready for its union by the initial two months of each calendar year. After its removal, the seed has to be soaked in water for a number of days. Make sure the outer most red casing is removed. Once it is properly soaked, then during spring, you can plant the seed but the trick is to do it sideways in the soil with only the top edge exposed. Normally, the seedling begins to etch out in three months but the plant will take years to fully develop.

Yet another way through which the Sago Palms can be propagated without hand pollination is by off-setting a healthy Sago Palm with a small shovel. Then it should be left to dry for a minimum period of seven days before being planted and watered.

Sago Palms make exquisite plants. It is vital to keep in mind that proper Sago Palm care, though a little complicated, is necessary to the existence of the plant. A spectacular plant can only be achieved through appropriate care and nourishment.
